

Language Option (French) 2020

La Salle College offers French as a Language option preparing boys for the Cambridge International Examination (CIE) AS French 8682 Exam. However, to fulfill local University requirements, boys studying French (or any other language) are also required to attain at least Level 3 in HKDSE Chinese or in special circumstances, pass an alternative recognized Chinese Exam such as GCSE Chinese or IGCSE Chinese.

At La Salle College, boys who have completed six years in a regular Chinese Language class in Primary School in Hong Kong must take the HKDSE Core Chinese exam¹. Boys studying French at La Salle College who have not completed six years in a regular Chinese Language class in Primary School in Hong Kong must take the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) Chinese in May of their Form 5 year.

To accommodate both French and Chinese, La Salle College offers French as a subject in the timetable and Chinese via a combination of timetabled subject time and supplementary tutorials. The College does not have the resources to offer French to those boys doing the regular Core Chinese for the HKDSE.

¹ Note:

1. Students who will not be completing their Form 6 HKDSE and therefore do not wish to enroll in the appropriate Chinese language course must submit a letter of request to do so, addressed to the Principal, with this application.
2. Students who have completed 6 years in a regular Chinese language class in Primary school who wish to take French must submit a letter of request to do so, addressed to the Principal, with this application. Given EDB regulations, approval is likely only in very exceptional circumstances.
